- How much of their money came from their own funds?



# Key questions: Spending

- What's their "burn rate"? Are they spending more than they raise?
- Which vendors earned the most money?
- What portion of the spending do the top vendors account for?
- Did they pay any family members for services?
- How did they spend their leadership PAC funds? Mostly on politics or something else?



Pay attention to what portion of spending went to contributions to other candidates





Issue One and Campaign Legal Center found that the leadership PACs of 120 members of Congress spent less than 50% on politics between January 2019 and December 2020. Moreover, 43 members of Congress spent less than 25% on politics during this time. And a handful spent at least five figures without ever contributing a penny to any local, state, or federal candidates, parties, or political groups. In contrast, during the same period, the typical member of Congress' leadership PAC spent 70% on politics.

Low portions of spending on politics could make for good stories

# **Key questions: Elections**

- Who's outraising whom? Who's outspending whom?
  - Is a challenger outraising/outspending an incumbent?
- How much are outside groups spending?
  - Are super PACs & other outside groups spending more in the race than the candidates?
- What's their "burn rate"?
  - Are candidates spending more money than they are raising?
- Are different industries/donors backing different candidates?







The Candidate Campaign Finance Guidelines were published by the Office of the Secretary of State to act as a comprehensive guide to aid candidates in complying with campaign finance disclosure and reporting requirements as outlined in the Campaign Reporting Act and the Campaign Finance Rule, NMAC 1.10.13. 





### Who Profited from Election Deniers?

As election-denying secretary of state candidates raised large sums in 2022, political consultants behind the scenes were raking in the dough.

JAN 17, 2023

#### Milk Consulting: \$16,000

Audrey Trujillo, the unsuccessful GOP nominee for secretary of state in New Mexico, spent 24% of her campaign money (nearly \$16,000) at Milk Consulting. This ranked the company as the top beneficiary of her campaign's spending. Milk Consulting is a political consulting firm based in Las Vegas, Nevada, that specializes in social media and advertising. Its <u>website</u> refers to the company's CEO, Robert Duran, as "the only true America First News Influencer" who "champions the forgotten men and women of the United States." The company also sells pro-Trump merchandise.

Like other "social welfare" nonprofits organized under Sec. 501(c)(4) of the U.S. tax code, the Kentucky Opportunity Coalition is generally not required to reveal the names of its financial supporters.

It must, however, list the amounts given by big donors. In 2014 alone, three unknown megadonors alone accounted for more than 60 percent of the \$15 million the Kentucky Opportunity Coalition raised. The largest donor <u>contributed \$5 million</u>. Another gave about \$3.4 million. A third gave \$1 million.





- Does an online search of the LLC's name yield any meaningful information or news stories?
- Does the LLC have a website?
- Does the LLC have a social media presence?
- What results does a Twitter search of the company's name yield?
- What results does a Google x-ray search of .gov websites plus the company's name yield? How about a Google x-ray search of .xls files and .pdf files?



- Is the LLC registered in the state of its address listed in FEC filings?
  - If not, does the company's name yield any positive hits on **OpenCorporates**?
  - Is the company registered in Delaware?



Examine the LLC's business records

- What, if anything, do the business records say about the primary purpose of the LLC?
- Whose names are listed on the articles of incorporation or any other business records?
  - Is the only name listed a lawyer or employee at a firm that specializes in incorporation services?
  - Do the filings list the LLC's actual members or owners?
- Investigate the people whose names are listed
  - What results do Google searches vield about these people?
  - How about Google x-ray searches of .gov websites?
  - Use FEC.gov, OpenSecrets.org, and FollowTheMoney.org to determine if they have made political contributions in their own name in the past.
- When was the LLC donor incorporated? How much time elapsed between the date of its incorporation and the date of its donation?





Examine the LLC's address

- Is the LLC's address a P.O. Box? A space in an industrial office park? Someone's home?
- What results do online searches of the LLC's address including Google x-ray searches of .gov websites — yield?
- Are other companies associated with this address?
- What do property records show about who owns the land associated with the address of the LLC?
- Use FEC.gov, OpenSecrets.org, and FollowTheMoney.org to learn if its address has ever appeared in federal or state campaign finance data or if the name of the LLC has appeared as an individual donor's employer.
